



5900 SOUTH IMPROVEMENTS

State Street to 700 West

Project Improvements



Murray City will begin construction on the 5900 South improvements on Monday, April 4. The project will include:

- Full removal and reconstruction of the pavement
- Widen and realign 300 West intersection to improve safety at the TRAX crossing
- Upgrade pedestrian ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Replace curb, gutter and sidewalk in areas that are deficient
- Replace existing water line and storm drain

Construction Schedule and Restrictions

Crews will be onsite as early as Monday, April 4, 2016, to begin preliminary construction activities such as utility locating, surveying and the placement of traffic control devices. The work will begin at the west end of the project at 700 West and move eastward toward State Street. Construction activities will be completed in three segments: the first will extend from 700 West to Commerce Drive, the second from Commerce Drive to 300 West, and the third from 300 West to State Street. Each phase will take approximately 4 months to complete with phase 1 beginning on April 4, phase 2 beginning in late spring and phase 3 beginning in mid-summer.

Local traffic (residents that live on 5900 South only) and business access will be maintained at all times; however, traffic will be restricted to one lane with the use of flaggers and heavy delays are anticipated. We encourage motorists to avoid the area and use detours. Work will take place six days a week from sunrise to sunset through late fall.
