

## Spring Snow Crabapple:

<b>Description</b>	A dense, oval upright tree with bright green leaves, turning yellow in the fall. Fragrant, single, white flowers appear in mid-spring. Fruitless variety. Hardy to -35°F Maximum Elevation: 8,000 ft.
<b>Deciduous Tree Type</b>	Flowering Tree
<b>Tree Habit</b>	Round
<b>Mature Size (generic)</b>	TREE (10-20' Tall) • Broad Canopy
<b>Fall Color</b>	Dramatic
<b>Features</b>	Showy Flowers, Fragrant Flowers

## Frontier Elm:

<b>Description</b>	This Elm is resistant to Dutch Elm Disease. It has reddish-purple fall color. Very tough and tolerant of a wide variety of conditions. This tree is a cross between Lacebark Elm and Smooth Leaf Elm. Hardy to -30°F Maximum Elevation: 6,000 ft.

## Hackberry:

<b>Description</b>	Hardy shade tree with wide spread, upright arching branches and light green foliage creating an open, airy appearance. The foliage turns yellow in fall. Fruit ripens to red in fall. Hardy to -50°F. Drought tolerant. Maximum Elevation: 7,000 ft.
<b>Deciduous Tree Type</b>	Shade Tree
<b>Tree Habit</b>	Round, Upright, Spreading, Arching Branches
<b>Mature Size (generic)</b>	TREE (30-50' Tall) • Broad Canopy
<b>Fall Color</b>	Subtle
<b>Features</b>	Grown For Attractive Foliage
<b>Flowering Season</b>	Spring
<b>USDA Hardiness Zone</b>	2, 3, 4, 5
<b>Water Needs</b>	Moderate
<b>Growth Rate</b>	Moderate

Ivory Silk Japanese Tree Lilac: **Limited quantity available.**

<b>Description</b>	A most attractive, small flowering tree with a compact, oval growth habit. Large, creamy white flower clusters bloom in early summer among the rich green foliage. The shiny bark is quite attractive. Hardy to -20°F Maximum Elevation: 6,000 Feet
<b>Deciduous Tree Type</b>	Flowering Tree
<b>Tree Habit</b>	Upright, Oval
<b>Mature Size (generic)</b>	TREE (20-30' Tall) • Narrow or Columnar
<b>Fall Color</b>	Subtle
<b>Features</b>	Showy Flowers, Winter Interest
