

Murray City History Advisory Board Minutes for October 24, 2018

1. The minutes from August and September were voted on and passed as written.
2. Museum update: Jennifer reported on her plans for the City Hall display cases. She is planning to feature the following artifacts along with the family histories that go along with them.
 - a. James T. Erikson Family
 - b. Pett Family
 - c. Pilati Family
 - d. Wright Family
 - e. Young Family

She explained that some of the families have voiced concerns about their donations not being shown or displayed so we want to make sure these donations get the attention they deserve.

3. StEPS museum training: Lori, Katie and Jennifer will be attending the next all - day training on Monday, October 29th and will review module #1 which was on mission, vision, governance, and strategic planning.

We will keep the written draft and edit it as needed when we see what direction we are headed when we know where our new home for the museum will be located.
