Minutes for May 22, 2019

- I. Minutes for April 24, 2019 were approved as written.
- II. Staff reports -Lori reported that she and Katie attended the State Historic Preservation Review Board for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places for the following properties:
 - 187 E. 5600 S. – Alfred & Hennie Huetter house
 - 198 W. Winchester St. – Mathew & Johanna Rowan house
 - 1697 E. Vine St. – Ray & Ethel Smith house
 - 604 E. Taylor Lane - Thomas & Margaret Taylor house

The committee suggested that there be a bit more information to be gathered on the Taylor house, but will watch for the edits to come through and sent all the other buildings on to the nomination process with the National Register.

Julie Winder, the new owner of the Taylor property was the only property owner at the meeting, although all the owners were invited. Lori and Katie introduced themselves to Julie and invited her to board meeting in May and told her they would copy the information of her house for her as it was built by a prominent architect that has built structures across the United States.

Lori reported that Korral Broschinsky finished the ILS boundary increase on the Murray Downtown Residential District. Lori explained that Korral is sending her some dates for a community meeting where homeowners will be invited to learn what being added to the Downtown Historic Register means. Lori will have Korral present a power-point and will ask someone from State Historic Preservation Office to attend as well to discuss tax credits.

- III. Ordinance Review – In April, Lori asked the board to read through the City Ordinance, 17.170.070: Historic Preservation, to become familiar with the rules that it sets. Tonight, the board read through the ordinance together to briefly discuss and interpret the document so that when the City changes the ordinance, they will be aware of what it says and what it means.
