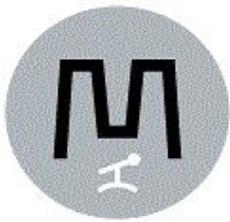

NOTICE OF MIDTERM VACANCY IN CITY COUNCIL OFFICE -- DISTRICT 1

Notice is hereby given that the Murray City Municipal Council has a Council seat vacancy for Council District 1 as of July 18, 2023 and will be accepting applications from interested individuals to fill the vacancy. The appointment will be to fill the unexpired term of the vacated office and will last until a newly elected Council Member for Council District 1 is sworn in on January 2, 2024.

The City Council will hold an open and public meeting on August 8, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, Murray City Hall, 10 East 4800 South, Murray, Utah for purposes of interviewing all applicants. After conducting the interviews, the City Council will vote to select an interim City Council member for Council District 1. After voting, the Council will appoint and have sworn in the interim Municipal Council member for Council District 1 to serve until January 2, 2024.

To be considered for the appointment as an interim Murray City Municipal Council member for Council District 1, applications must be received by Jennifer Kennedy, City Council Executive Director, at the Murray City Hall Council office, 10 East 4800 South, Room 290, Murray, Utah, **no later than 5:00 pm on Thursday, August 3, 2023**. Application forms are available at the Murray City Council office and the Murray City website (www.murray.utah.gov).

An applicant must be a registered voter, a resident of Murray City for at least 12 consecutive months prior to appointment and a resident of District 1. (Additionally, Utah law prohibits a mentally incompetent individual, an individual convicted of a felony, or an individual convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise from holding office until the right to hold elective office is restored.)


Order to Convene a Special Meeting of the Murray City Municipal Council to Appoint an Interim City Council Member for Council District 1 to Serve Until January 2, 2024

RESOLUTION NO. R23-

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING [REDACTED] AS INTERIM MURRAY CITY COUNCIL MEMBER FOR COUNCIL DISTRICT 1, PURSUANT TO SECTION 20A-1-510 OF THE UTAH CODE TO SERVE UNTIL JANUARY 2, 2024.

WHEREAS, a vacancy occurred on the Murray City Municipal Council for Council District 1 on July 18, 2023; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 20A-1-510(1) of the Utah Code, the City Council must make an appointment of an Interim Council Member for Council District 1 within thirty (30) days after the date of vacancy; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2023, the City published notice as provided by law stating the following: (1) there is a vacancy on the Murray City Municipal Council for Council District 1; (2) as a result of the vacancy, the City Council needs to appoint an Interim Council Member for Council District 1; (3) the City Council will accept applications from qualified registered voters of the City to be considered by the City Council for appointment as the Interim Council Member for Council District 1; (4) the deadline for applications was August 3, 2023; (5) the applications must be submitted to Jennifer Kennedy, Council Executive Director at the City Council Office, 10 East 4800 South, Room 290, Murray, Utah; (6) the City Council will interview all interested candidates in a duly noticed open meeting on August 8, 2023; and (7) following interviews in the open meeting, the City Council will appoint an Interim Council Member for Council District 1 to serve as a Council Member for Council District 1 until January 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Council received on or before August 3, 2023 applications from the following qualified registered voters of the City: Roberto "Paul" Pickett, and David Rodgers; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2023, in a duly noticed open meeting, the City Council interviewed: Roberto "Paul" Pickett, and David Rodgers; and

WHEREAS, following the interviews in the open meeting on August 8, 2023, and in accordance with section 20A-1-510(1) of the Utah Code, the City Council, voted on who should be appointed Interim Council Member for Council District 1 among all the interviewed candidates; and

WHEREAS, in the meeting on August 8, 2023, [REDACTED] was chosen by majority vote (or coin toss); and

WHEREAS, the City Council wants to appoint [REDACTED] as the Interim Council Member for Council District 1, to serve until January 2, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Murray City Council as follows:

1. Pursuant to section 20A-1-510 of the Utah Code and section 2.04.070 of the Murray City Municipal Code, [REDACTED] is hereby appointed as Interim Council Member for Council District 1, to serve until a newly elected Council Member is sworn into office on January 2, 2024, with all authority and responsibilities provided to Murray City Council Members by State law and Murray City ordinances and policies.
2. [REDACTED], as an Interim Council Member, shall be compensated as provided in Murray City ordinances.
