### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2015, beginning at 6:30 p.m. of said day in the Council Chambers of the Murray City Center, 5025 South State Street, Murray, Utah, the Murray City Municipal Council will hold and conduct a Public Hearing on and pertaining to the following proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget:

1. Roll over funds in the Capital Projects Fund from the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Budget to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget of \$19,682 appropriated for the General Plan study.
2. Roll over funds in the Capital Projects Fund the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Budget to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget of \$65,000 appropriated for the Citrix Software.
3. Roll over funds in the Solid Waste Fund from the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Budget to the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Budget of \$40,000 appropriated for the Solid Waste garbage containers.
4. Increase the General Fund by \$4,250 as revenue from the Fire Emergency Management Performance Grant.
5. Increase the General Fund by \$14,214 as revenue from the Police State Homeland Security Program Grant.
6. Transfer \$10,000 from the Nondepartmental's Budget to Public Services Budget (cemetery) and appropriate \$10,000 for GIS mapping project.
7. Transfer \$9,100 from the Nondepartmental's Budget to City Council Budget and appropriate \$9100 for full time employee change.
8. Decrease the Solid Waste Fund Reserves by \$7,000 and appropriate \$7,000 for natural gas garbage truck.
9. Increase the Capital Projects Fund by \$25,000 as revenue from Salt Lake County for the Sharrows on Vine Project.
10. Increase the Water Fund Reserves by \$4,900 as revenue from Insurance Proceeds and appropriate \$4,900 for Water compensatory time payout.
11. Increase the Capital Projects Fund by \$14,309 as revenue from the Police car accident insurance payment.

12. Decrease the Retained Risk Funds Reserves by \$50,000 and appropriate \$50,000 for Retained Risk claims payments.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comment concerning the proposed amendments to the City's 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Budget.
