Please be aware that due to the COVID-19 outbreak/pandemic, Governor Herbert has declared a state of emergency. To protect the public and all court participants it has become necessary for the Utah Judiciary to implement it's Pandemic Response Plan. Effective March 21, 2020, Justice Courts cannot hear any cases involving defendants who are charged with violations of the traffic code until after 10/01/2020.

If you had a court date scheduled for April, May or June, it has been canceled. We will be notifying you by mail of a new court date to be scheduled after 10/01/2020. These notices will be mailed out in September of 2020. Please contact the court to make sure we have your correct address, phone number, and email address in order for us to get the information to you. Our number is 801-284-4280.
