1300 East to Van Winkle Expressway

OVERVIEW


Murray City is preparing for the engineering design of phase two of the Vine Street Improvement Project from 1300 East to Van Winkle. Vine Street functions as an east-west road providing the community with access to 900 East, 1300 East, Van Winkle and I-215. The roadway has varying widths and lacks continuous sidewalks, curb and gutter, shoulders and turning lanes making it unsafe for all users. The overall goal of this project is to provide a safe and complete street for all users by providing access for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists. This will be accomplished by:

- Continuous sidewalks
- Bike lanes
- Center turn lane
- Roadway shoulders
- Upgraded utilities
- Improving the drainage system
- New roadway surface
- Minimizing impacts to adjacent properties

PROCESS

A roadway concept was prepared during the early phase of the project. This concept will be refined and modified throughout the engineering design process. Decisions are not final and this is your opportunity to be part of the process. This will include:

- Investigation and evaluation of utilities near the road and other existing conditions
- Consideration of various options to meet project objectives
- Meetings with affected property owners
- Public outreach/meetings with stakeholders



UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

Throughout the summer, project team members will be near the road assessing existing conditions and evaluating the various utilities. This helps guide the engineering design process with current and accurate information. Upcoming activities include:

- Project site visits to determine existing conditions
- Land survey to determine locations of property lines and utilities
- Property owner meetings
