## COVID-19 Business Relief Resources

Dear Murray Business Owner,

The COVID-19 pandemic has created undefined and trying times and have greatly impacted the economy and businesses licensed within Murray City. Although Murray City doesn't have any in-house programs to assist our businesses, the global crisis has been met with a number of responses and programs funded by the federal, state and county levels, and Murray City wants to ensure you are aware of these resources.

Murray City has partnered with Salt Lake County to administer CARES Act funds and to serve as a conduit for information and resources for businesses, community stakeholders, and residents suffering hardship during this time. A Business Relief Hotline has been set up by Salt Lake County and is available in several languages. If you have been impacted by the pandemic, we encourage you to call the Business Relief Hotline to explore available resources to assist your business.

Through our partnership with Salt Lake County, the *Small Business Impact Grant* is available for small businesses (those who employ less than 100 individuals) who are located in Salt Lake County. The overall funding includes \$40 million in financial aid to help business owners most directly impacted by the COVID-19 public health orders and subsequent closures. The grant is funded through the County's CARES Act funds allocation to assist in local recovery efforts.
