1300 East to Van Winkle Expressway

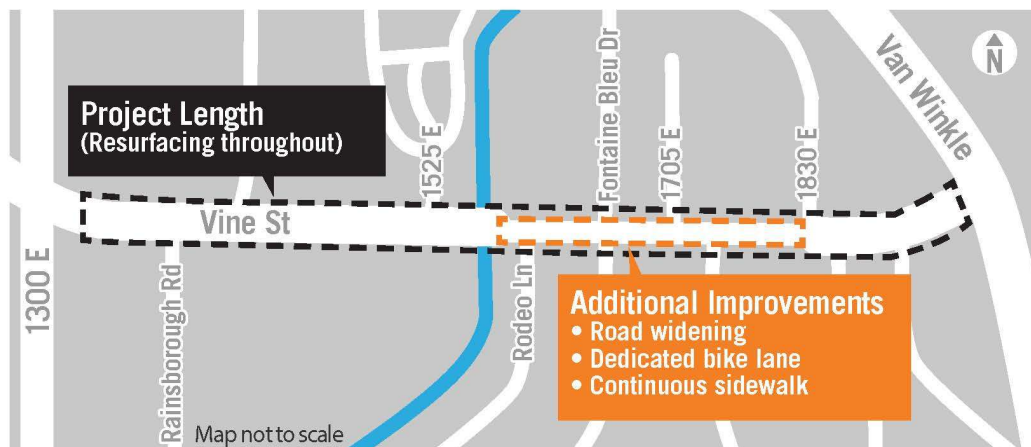
Construction of phase two of Murray City's Vine Street Improvement Project is expected to begin in early January 2022 and will continue through Fall 2022.* The overall goal of this project is to provide a safe and complete street for everyone by providing access for pedestrians, cyclists, and motorists.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS:

- Continuous sidewalks
- Bike lanes
- Center turn lane
- Roadway shoulders
- Upgraded utilities
- Improved drainage system
- New roadway surface

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Daytime construction work Monday – Friday
- Occasional weekend construction work
- Bicyclist and pedestrian restrictions within the construction area
- Intermittent driveway and side street access closures within the construction area
- On-street parking restrictions within the construction area
- Increased construction vehicles, lane restrictions, travel delays, noise, dust and vibration
