

ORDINANCE NO. 25-22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025  
BUDGET

On August 13, 2024, the Murray City Municipal Council adopted the City's budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. It has been proposed that the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget be amended as follows:

1. Receive and appropriate the following grants and/or reimbursements in the General Fund with no financial impact:
  - a. Increase the budget \$36,689 from Asset Forfeiture receipts and appropriate for police equipment and new officer on boarding expense, and;
  - b. Increase the budget \$15,000 from an Intermountain Health donation and appropriate for the Love, Murray marketing campaign, and;
  - c. Increase the budget \$229,845 from the LA Fire deployment and appropriate for \$213,769 for fire salaries, benefits, travel, vehicle maintenance, building maintenance and transfer \$16,076 of the reimbursement to the Capital Improvements Projects Fund.
2. In the Capital Improvements Projects Fund receive \$16,076 from the General Fund and appropriate to Fire equipment
3. In the Power Fund receive \$19,090,000 of Bond Proceeds and appropriate \$90,000 to cost of issuance, \$3,600,000 to infrastructure, and \$15,400,000 to reserves.

Section 10-6-128 of the Utah Code states that the budget for the City may be amended by the Murray City Municipal Council following a duly noticed public hearing. Pursuant to proper notice, the Murray City Municipal Council held a public hearing on June 17 2025, to consider proposed amendments to the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget. After considering public comment, the Murray City Municipal Council wants to amend the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget.

*Section 1. Enactment.* The City's Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget shall be amended as follows:

1. Receive and appropriate the following grants and/or reimbursements in the General Fund with no financial impact:

- a. Increase the budget \$36,689 from Asset Forfeiture receipts and appropriate for police equipment and new officer on boarding expense, and;
  - b. Increase the budget \$15,000 from an Intermountain Health donation and appropriate for the Love, Murray marketing campaign, and;
  - c. Increase the budget \$229,845 from the LA Fire deployment and appropriate for \$213,769 for fire salaries, benefits, travel, vehicle maintenance, building maintenance and transfer \$16,076 of the reimbursement to the Capital Improvements Projects Fund.
2. In the Capital Improvements Projects Fund receive \$16,076 from the General Fund and appropriate to Fire equipment
  3. In the Power Fund receive \$19,090,000 of Bond Proceeds and appropriate \$90,000 to cost of issuance, \$3,600,000 to infrastructure, and \$15,400,000 to reserves.

*Section 2. Effective Date.* This Ordinance shall take effect on first publication.




