The Emergence of Murray City

Schools outside Murray, scout troops, and private groups are invited to schedule a 60-90 minute tour of the Murray City Museum. School tours include the city council chambers and Mayor's office, and are typically scheduled on Tuesday or Thursday mornings between 9:30-11 am throughout the school year. After-school tours for scout groups can be scheduled between 3:30-5 pm on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday. If absolutely necessary, we may be able to accept alternative dates and times. **School reservations or groups exceeding 20 people must be scheduled at least one month in advance.**

Our museum is small! Large groups may be divided up into 2 groups of no more than 20 participants each, due to our space restrictions within the exhibits. We cannot accommodate groups larger than 50 in a single visit; if your group is larger than 50, we may ask that you divide your group into 2 and bring them on different days.
